### TRASH & RECYCLING:

If you live within village limits, trash is collected every Wednesday.; recycling every other Wednesday. In the town, you must contract with a hauler on your own. Recycling is every other Friday. Visit the Tompkins County Solid Waste website for more information.

## 2010 CENSUS & DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION:

### AREA:

Ulysses has a total area of 36.8 square miles (33.0 square miles is land and 3.9 square miles, or 10.48%, is water). The eastern town line is at Cayuga Lake, one of the Finger Lakes.

### POPULATION:

4,900 people (2,075 households/1,406 families)

### MEDIAN AGE: 45.9 years

### FAMILIES:

34.4% of households had one or more children under the age of eighteen (18) and 26.9% of households had one or more individual over the age of sixty-five (65).

### EDUCATION:

Of the population of 25 years or older, 47% have a bachelor's degree or higher and 94.8% have a high school degree or higher.

### MEDIAN INCOME:

\$61,023/household or \$70,179/family.

## **Do I live in Trumansburg or Ulysses?**

The Town of Ulysses includes the Village of Trumansburg within its limits. However, post office boundaries are different than municipal boundaries. Ulysses residents will have a mailing address of either Trumansburg NY 14886 or Ithaca NY 14850. 

**ZONING:**

The Town has a history of proactively regulated land use, which ensures that land is used in a manner that best serves the health, safety, and welfare of the entire community. In 2009 the Town updated its Comprehensive Plan (or town master plan). If you are planning to build, subdivide, or start a new business, the zoning guides



you on if, where, and how to accomplish your goal. View the zoning map online or at the town hall.

**BUILDING PERMITS/CODE ENFORCEMENT:**

Building permits are required for:

- Residential & commercial construction
- Alterations, renovations, additions, pools
- Accessory buildings over 120 sq. ft.
- Solar, wind or alt. energy installations
- Signs
- Woodstoves or heating units 
- Demolition

**WATER:**

- Ulysses operates a few water districts, mainly in the Jacksonville area. Visit our website for more information. 
- Most homes in the town have their own well/septic, regulated by Tompkins County Department of Health.
- The village offers municipal water/sewer maintained by their DPW.

The Town Board meets on the 2nd & 4th Tuesday of each month at 7pm at the Town Hall at 10 Elm Street. Agendas are posted in advance on the website. The public is encouraged to attend.
